The China Council for the Promotion of International Trade and The Federation of Jordanian Chambers of Commerce (here-in-afer referred to as the two parties), desiring to promote the development of the mutual cooperation and economic and trade relationships between CHINA and JORDAN and creating conditions more favourable for further cooperation between their member enterprises, have arrived at the following agreement...

ARTICLE 1

The two parties shall assist associations, companies and organizations within their territory to forge business ties in finding potential partners in trade, economic and industrial cooperation. For that purpose they shall encourage participations in exhibitions, meetings, conferences, and exchange of delegations.

ARTICLE 2

They shall exchange and familiarize themselves with the legislations and regulations in force in each other's country relevant to the foreign economic relations. They shall provide each other with the other party's publications when such publications are useful for this task.

ARTICLE 3

They will publish in their publications the information relating to mutual international supply and demand of merchandise, services and technical cooperation.

ARTICLE 4

The two parties will do all within their power for the elimination of such obstacles which may obstruct continuous both-way flow of goods and the steady increase of reciprocal trade by pointing out these barriers and working at their removal.

ARTICLE 5

Exchange of information shall be counducted in regard to trade. economic cooperation and services between the two countries.

ARTICLE 6

This agreement enters into force as of the date of signing. It is renewable every year by silent approval. It may be terminated by either part giving six months' advance notice.

This agreement is signed in Amman on the First day of June, 1996, in duplicate.

Agreement for the Establishment of Jordanian-Chinese Business Council (JCBC)

Mindful of the interests and endeavours of the business communities in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the People's Republic of China, and aiming at strengthening the economic relations between the two countries, promoting trade, industry and joint investments, and bringing together business persons from all sectors of the economy.

The Jordan Businessmen Association, the Jordan Chamber of Commerce, and the Jordan Chamber of Industry on one side, and the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade-CCPIT, on the other side(herein called the Parties) agree to jointly establish the:

"Jordanian-Chinese Business Council"

- The Jordanian-Chinese Business Council (JCBC) is a non-government consultative body designed to render assistance in developing direct business relations between the Jordanian and Chinese firms, organizations and entrepreneurs, and implementing actions intended to develop economic cooperation between them in all sectors of the economy.
- Within the framework of the JCBC, the Parties shall promote regular exchange of economic, trade and business information and entrepreneurial experience.
- -The Parties shall undertake actions to help each other in the development of fairs and exhibition activities, organizing economic, technical and investments seminars, symposiums, conferences and other events aimed at expanding the bilateral trade, economic and investment cooperation, as well as the promotion of tourism activities.
- The Parties shall facilitate and promote the exchange of business delegations seeking to examine the prospects for cooperation in the fields of industry, trade, tourism and
- The JCBC shall promote and encourage the transfer of technology and know-how in all fields, in addition to implementing specialized training programs in both countries.

The present Agreement shall take effect from the date of its signing.

The Agreement may be terminated not earlier than three months after the date of written notification by either Party about its intention to cancel the Agreement
