**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

- a) Both Parties will encourage the exchange of trade missions and agree to support with all reasonable preparation, the business programs of the visiting delegations of the other Party.
- b) The Parties undertake to supply relevant market information, facilitate business networking and introduction to representatives of concerned industries.

**TRADE**

**ARTICLE 2**

The Parties shall take all necessary measures to promote trade relations in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement and subject to the domestic laws in their respective countries.

**GENERAL PRINCIPLE**

**ARTICLE 1**

**HAVE AGREED** as follows:

**FURTHER** recognizing the importance of establishing a framework as the basis for such cooperation:

**RECOGNIZING** that the parties' mutual desire to enhance relations with each other will support, complement, strengthen and extend cooperation between the parties

**DESIRIOUS** to promote commercial exchange between the Republic of Kenya and The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

**Jordan Chamber of Industry** which acts as a national body which embodies all the other chambers of industry in Jordan. It seeks to represent the interests of these chambers and to enhance cooperation and full coordination among them.

**KNCCI** is along established business membership organization of the business community with extensive and countrywide county network in Kenya operating with its core Mandate of promoting, protecting and developing the interest of its members and the entire business community by fostering a business friendly environment.

**Whereas:**

The Kenya National Chamber of Commerce & Industry (KNCCI) of the Republic of Kenya and the Jordan Chamber of Industry of The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties" in plural and "the Party" in the singular).

**PREAMBLE**

Unless otherwise mutually agreed upon, visiting trade missions shall provide their own travel and accommodation expenses and any other costs incurred during their stay in the respective countries.

## FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

### ARTICLE 6

- a) Both Parties agree to contribute expertise and experiences to the organization of courses, symposia and other activities held both in Jordan and Kenya in order to obtain a more thorough knowledge of trade and investment opportunities between both Parties.
- b) Both Parties agree to support various projects including startups and vocational Training programs

## TRAINING

### ARTICLE 5

- a) The Parties agree to share market information on important economic and trade issues including developments in their respective commercial legislation, which might affect trade relations between commercial enterprises and entities in Jordan and Kenya.
- b) Both Parties agree to establish regular exchange of publications edited by the respective institutions.
- c) Both Parties agree to set an open link on their respective websites as means to exchange business information.
- d) Both Parties agree to use logos of each party during joint events

## BUSINESS INFORMATION

### ARTICLE 4

- a) Each of the Parties agree to exchange information about international fairs and exhibitions to be held in Jordan and Kenya and to grant each other technical support to encourage the participation of the respective enterprises and entities in events of their interest.
- b) Both Parties agree to exchange know how and experiences on organizing and managing trade fairs and conferences.

## EXHIBITIONS AND TRADE FAIRS

### ARTICLE 3

- a) This agreement will enter into force on the date of signature and shall remain in force for a period of three years.
- b) This agreement shall automatically be renewed for successive periods of three years unless either Party notifies the other in writing of its intention to terminate the agreement six months prior to the expiry of any such period.
- c) Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either Party may terminate the agreement by notifying the other Party of its intention to terminate this agreement by a notice in writing at least six months prior to its intention to do so.
- d) The termination of this agreement shall not affect the implementation of ongoing activities/programs which have been agreed upon prior to the date of the termination of the agreement.

#### ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

#### ARTICLE 9

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application on any clause of this agreement shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties.

#### SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES


#### ARTICLE 8

- a) Either party may request an amendment of this agreement by giving notice to the other party.
- b) No amendment of this agreement shall be valid and binding unless in writing and signed by both parties.
- c) Any amendments of this agreement shall not adversely affect any rights or obligations accrued or incurred prior to the date of the amendment of the agreement.


#### AMENDMENTS
